

Desert Island

Equipment:

- Cards with items printed on them (enough for one set per person)
- Paper
- Pencils

Story:

The boat is sinking on a coral reef near a deserted island and you only have enough room in your pocket to carry three things.

Method:

1. Each girl is given a list of ten items that she may take to the island
2. From that list she may only choose 3 of those things
3. When everyone has finished choosing get each girl to explain what they have taken and why they choose it.
4. Then get the patrol as a whole group to work together to decide what three items they would like to take.

Story:

Progressive Miming

Equipment:

Method:

1. One member of the Patrol mimes an action connected with a job in the home.
2. As soon as someone else in the Patrol knows what the job is being done, she adds another bit of the mime. The first person nods her head if she is correct or shakes it if she is incorrect.
3. The mime continues until everyone knows what the job is being done and has added a bit of mime.
4. Then the next person starts
5. No-one is allowed to talk during this activity.

Drawing in The Dark

Equipment:

Paper

Pens

Enough blindfolds for every girl

Some pictures from a colouring book

Method:

1. Each girl is given paper, pen and blindfold.
2. All the girls are blindfolded
3. They each take turns in being a leader
4. The Leader describes a picture and as the girls to draw it.

Only I saw It

Equipment:

Paper

Pens

Some pictures from a colouring book

Method:

1. Each gets a turn in being a leader.
2. The leader is shown a picture.
3. She has to describe this to the rest of the patrol without actually saying what it is.
4. If questions are asked she can only answer yes or no.
5. The first one to correctly draw the picture wins.

CopyCat

Equipment:

Ten matches per girl

Method:

1. Girls get into pairs.
2. Each girl is given ten matches.
3. Each pair sits back to back.
4. One of the girl makes a shape in front of her on the floor
5. She then describes it to the other girl, who has to duplicate the design.
6. The girls swap when finished.
