Patrol Name Game

Equipment:

- Paper
- Pencils

Method:

1. Give each girl paper and a pencil.
2. Each player has to write the name of your patrol on the top of the piece of paper.
3. On the word go, each person has to think up as many words as they can using only the letters from your patrol name.

“Me” Collage

Equipment:

- Magazines
- Paper
- Glue

Method:

1. Ask the girls to describe themselves with pictures by choosing and cutting out words, photos, or symbols from the magazine that remind the girls of themselves. Some ideas include things they like to eat, places they have been, people or animals that are special to them.
2. Glue these onto a piece of paper to form a collage that displays who they are.

Good Turn Dice

Equipment:

Good turn dice

Method:

Each girl in the patrol are to throw the dice to each other and mime the good turn for the other members of her patrol to guess.

Shopping Spree

Equipment:

- Dice
- Paper
- Pen

Method:

1. Your Patrol has had a windfall of \$1440. You need to decide on what you spend your funds.
2. Sit in a circle, one person starts by throwing a dice. Each member has a turn until a 6 is thrown. The patrol member who has thrown a 6 can look through a magazine and decide on one item **she** would like to buy with the patrol funds.
3. Continue to throw the dice in turn until all the patrol funds are spent.
How did you feel to have someone else spend your money?
Did the others try to change her mind?
Do you take as much time and care in spending our time as we do our spending money?

My Name Game

Equipment:

- Paper
- Pen

Idea:

To help girls identify qualities in other people, as well as within themselves.

Method

1. The girls write their names in large letters across the whole sheet of paper.
2. They then come together sitting in a circle and pass their name around the circle.
3. Girls write positive things about that person using one of the letters in the girls' name as the starting letter of a positive attribute.
